Re: OSA Mini Rules

The SRSL has received a few inquiries regarding OSA Mini Rules.

In the current OSA mini rules, they are silent with regards to deliberate kicks to the goal keeper.

The league has contacted the OSA for clarification and wanted to inform all clubs and team officials of our findings.

Rule 12 deals with free kicks for misconducts. Because the rule about the goalie handling the ball when it is deliberately kicked or thrown to him/her by a team mate is not included in Rule 12 this means that it is not an infraction.

The referee must not stop the game should this occur because it is not an infraction.

Although, in the OSA mini rules a deliberate kick to the goalies is not considered an infraction, the league strongly suggests that the players are educated and learn that starting at the under 11 age a deliberate kick to the goalie is punishable by a free kick.
