SRSL Rules regarding Uniforms Rule 8

The SRSL has received several inquiries regarding Uniforms. To assist in clarifying these inquiries we have put together the following for clarification:

SRSL Rule 8C: Read as follows:

All Players, including goalies, must be identified by a number, minimum size "8" on the back of their shirt and such number will be recorded against the players' name on the game sheet. All numbers must be legible. No two players on the same team may wear the same number.

Clarification:

A goalie is considered a player therefore if the team decides to switch the goalie during the game the new goalie coming into the game must have a different jersey number in order to play.

If the team is unable to supply a different number for the new goalie the player cannot play and this would result with the team playing without a goalie or the game being abandoned.

As per Appendix A the Club will be fined \$250.00 for Club/Team failing to comply with league rules.

In addition, the referee will be reported to the district for not following the league rules.
