



SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

The Pyramid for Play for soccer in Ontario is a hierarchy of leagues structured to provide opportunities for every player to play soccer at a level appropriate to his/her skill and ability, from the Club level to the Provincial level. The South Region Soccer League (SRS�) represents the largest segment of this hierarchy in the area for youth soccer, combining teams in the Peel, Halton, Hamilton, and Niagara regions. Teams progress from the club level through 3-6 divisions in the SRS�, to the single division in the Ontario Youth Soccer League (OYSL).

The SRS� is proud to offer players the opportunity to enjoy the sport, while increasing their skill level through competitive league play.

As such, we would like to recognize those individuals who best exemplify the spirit of fair play, who possess the ability to balance both academic and athletic success, and who display leadership skills on and off the field, in the pursuit of excellence.

The SRS� will present four scholarship awards annually, two for male players and two for female players. Each award will be for an amount of \$1,000.00 (total amount not to exceed \$4,000.00), to players/candidates who qualify based on the following selection criteria;

1. A student enrolled in Grade 12 or equivalent and graduating during the current calendar year.
2. A student who maintains a minimum average of 75% during both Grade 12 semesters.
3. A candidate who has played in the South Region soccer League for a minimum of 3 years.
4. A candidate who has exemplified qualities of fair play, academic and athletic excellence, and leadership skills both on and off the field.
5. A candidate that has been accepted (or will be by the end of the current soccer season) at a recognized College or University to attend full-time studies.
6. A candidate who has been involved in community service work.
7. Application to be submitted prior to July 1st of each calendar year.

If the player/candidate fulfills these qualifications, their respective applications will be reviewed by an executive committee panel and 4 award recipients will be chosen. The awards will be presented at the conclusion of the U18 Cup Final each season. This award program will be reviewed annually and the SRS� executive reserves the right to make any necessary adjustments based on budgetary considerations. The deadline for submission is July 1st of each year.
